Eugene (Brud) Huff

Funeral services for Eugene (Brud) Huff, 79, of Grapeland, were held Dec. 19, at 3 p.m. in the First Baptist Church, Grapeland, with the Rev. Kenneth Mobley and the Rev. E. P., Ramsey officiating. Burial was in the Daly's Cemetery, west of Grapeland, under the direction of Hassell & Foster.

Grandsons served as pallbearers.

Lifelong resident of Grapeland, Mr. Huff was born July 12, 1895, a son of Hamilton Huff and Callie Pennington Huff, and he died Dec. 18 at 10:23 a.m. in a Palestine hospital following a long illness. Prior to retiring, he engaged in farming and ranching.

Survivors include five sons, Gene, Bill and Harvey Huff, all of Grapeland, Nolan Huff of Crockett, and Charles Huff of Austin; two daughters, Mrs. Charlie (Ima) Ashwood of Grapeland, and Mrs. Jack (Ann) Brown of Arlington; 20 grandchildren; eight great grandchildren; numerous nieces and nephews.

Preceded in death by wives, Mrs. Lorena Brown Huff, in March 1946, and Mrs. Bessie Mae Huff on Sept 15, 1970. Also, a daughter, Mrs. Luna Frank Matthews, on Jan. 2, 1950.
