Funeral services for Mr. William Harold Hughes, 26, of Crockett, were held in the Callaway Memorial Chapel at 2 p.m. Thursday, Jan. 26, with the Reverends G. H. Stieglitz, Full Gospel Temple pastor, and Jerry R. Yours Church of God pastor, officiating.

Interment was in the Wesley Chapel Cemetery, and pallbearers were A. C. Dykes Jr., Henry Brooks, W. A. Turner, J. W. Hailey, Roy Driskell, and Jim Edd Johnson.

Mr. Hughes, who died Tuesday, Jan. 24, of a gunshot wound, was born Jan. 7, 1935, in Lovelady. He was a veteran of the Korean War and was a member of the American Legion Post 134 in Crockett.
