TRINITY - Services for Dennis Mack Hurd, 50, of Lufkin were held at 11 a.m. Wednesday, May 31, 2006, in the Dorcas Wills Memorial Baptist Church in Trinity with the Rev. Leroy Brown officiating.

Mr. Hurd died Sunday, May 28, following a five year battle with colon cancer.

He was born Nov. 4, 1955, in Amarillo, the only son of Joan and Mack Hurd. He struggled with illness for most of his life, especially

during the last five years. While a resident at Marbridge House in Houston, he worked at the Houston Astrodome for 12 years. He was known for his patriotism and enjoyed celebrating each national holiday.
