

HARRISON L. HURST

Funeral services for Mr. Harrison L. Hurst, of Crockett, were held Saturday, May 3, in Nacogdoches with Tom Hurst, and the Rev. Wallace Everitt of Pattison and the Rev. H.F. Scott of Crockett officiating. Special songs were sung by Ann Hurst, sister-in-law of Harrison and his niece Christy Hurst Huggins of Nacogdoches.

Mr. Harrison L. Hurst passed away in the Lufkin Hospital on April 30, 2003.

Mr. Hurst graduated from Nacogdoches High School and Stephen F. Austin State University. Mr. Hurst was a radio broadcaster and political consultant having managed several state-wide and local political campaigns. Mr. Hurst also wrote and produced ads on a free lance basis. Mr. Hurst worked at several radio stations including KNOW and KLBJ in Austin, KSFA and KEEE in Nacogdoches, KGRI in Henderson, KLUF in Lufkin, etc.
