Mr. William Henry Hurtt, 46-year-old carpenter of Houston and native of Houston County, died Sunday, Jan. 8, in a Houston Hospital following a heart attack.

Funeral services were held at 3 p.m. Tuesday, Jan. 10, in the Callaway Memorial Chapel with the Reverends C. A. West, Methodist minister of Crockett, G. S. Rogers, Nazareneminister of Houston, and Carl Cochran Jr., Nazarene minister of Crockett, officiating.
