Funeral services for C. V. Ivy, age 63, of Crockett were held Tuesday, June 15, at Felders Chapel Assembly of God Church, east of Grapeland, with Rev. Randy Shipman and Rev. Doyle Hodge officiating. Burial followed in Davis Cemetery under the direction of Bailey & Foster-Grapeland.
