TRINITY -- Memorial services for Juanita (Mickey) Jamieson, 80, were held Friday, April 19, 2002, in the First Presbyterian Church of Trinity.

Mrs. Jamieson died Monday, April 15, in the Hospice of East Texas in Tyler after sustaining a severe head injury on March 16.
