**Theodore 'Ted' Johnson**

TRINITY – Services for Theodore "Ted" Johnson, 78, were held at 11 a.m. Wednesday, Oct. 24, 2007, at the Friendship Harbor Church with the Rev. John Budd, the Rev. Bragg and the Rev. Brown officiating. Burial followed in the Chita Cemetery in Trinity County.
