FLOYD PERSHING JUNG

Mr. Floyd Pershing Jung, age 86 of Inman, Kansas, passed away September 8, 2005 at Pleasant View Home, Inman. Mr. Jung was born November 24, 1918 near Lyons on a farm to Theodore and Bertha Sheperd Jung. Mr. Jung graduated from high school at Lyons. A resident of Inman since November 2003, moving from Texas. Mr. Jung worked for 7 years in the 1940s for DuPont Powder Plant at Carl Junction, Missouri and in 1950s, he was a pumper for Atlantic Richfield Oil Co. in Odessa for 29 years, retiring in December 1979.

His stint included; as private, bomb salvage technician; as Tec. 5. munitions worker and diesel locomotive engineer; as sergeant, ammunition NCO and also he had a private pilot's licence.
