Mrs. Daisy McConnell Kelley, of Houston, passed away Oct. 12 in her home. She was born May 19, 1908 in Crockett to William Van McConnell and Daisy McLean McConnell. She graduated with honors from Crockett High School in 1925 and from the University of Oklahoma in 1930 and was president of the Epsilon Alpha chapter of Chi Omega and selected to membership in Phi Beta Kappa. During the Great Depression she taught English at Baytown Jr. High School where she met and married Emory S. Kelley of Douglasville, Ga. She was selected as Chairperson of the 1966 National Meeting of the Council of English teachers.
