## Services Are Held Monday For Max Langham

Funeral services for Max Langham, age 65, of Grapeland were held Monday afternoon, August 20, in the First United Methodist Church with Rev. Keith Broyles officiating. Burial followed in the Grapeland City Cemetery under the direction of Bailey & Foster, Grapeland.
