Honorary pallbearers were members of the Black Dot Domino Club.

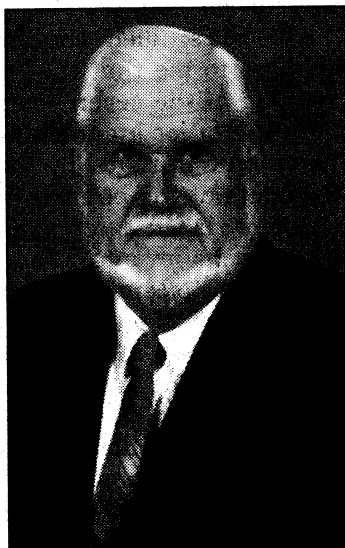
