Mr. Bobbyjack Luby Lewis, age 47 of Slater, passed away Saturday, January 20, 2007 at his home. Mr. Lewis was born August 31, 1959 in Ft. Worth.

Mr. Lewis graduated from Gatesville High School in 1978 and received a 12th Man Football Award his senior year. Mr. Lewis graduated from Tarleton State University with a Bachelor's Degree in Agriculture Education and a Master's Degree in Agriculture Science and Veterinary Science.

Mr. Lewis worked for the Texas Extension Service as a county agent in Crockett, and Sierra Blanca for nine years. Mr. Lewis was the proud co-owner and manager of Double L Wildlife. Mr. Lewis also managed his family's cattle for the past 15 years.

Mr. Lewis had a heart to help others which was evident in the way he lived his life. Mr. Lewis was very active in the community, serving on many boards and associations. Mr. Lewis was on the Board of the Coryell County Farm Bureau, was the Texas State chairman of the Wildlife program for the Blackland Income Growth Project, past-president of the Southwest Coryell Country Wildlife Management Association, president of the Slater Cemetery Association, and served actively with several other organizations.

Mr. Lewis was also selected to serve as one of the Texas State Reps for the Farm Bureau, a two-year term. During this time he traveled throughout North and South America learning how to improve agriculture in Texas. Mr. Lewis spent endless hours working with many counties' 4-H clubs and youth. Mr. Lewis enjoyed hearing and telling a good story. Mr. Lewis was also a member of Pearl Baptist Church.
