VALDOSTA, Ga. -- Services for Trinity native Frances Elizabeth Kennedy Lightsey, 71, of Valdosta, Ga. were held at 2 p.m. Friday, April 6, 2001, in the chapel of the Carson McLane Funeral Home with the Rev. John Curtis officiating.
