Slocum, and taught Sunday school for many years. Mr. and Mrs. Limerick moved to Lufkin about 12 years ago, and are currently members of Denman Avenue Baptist Church.

He was preceded in death by his son, Bobby Limerick, who was killed in Vietnam in 1971; his mother and father, Eltner and Eunice Maple; sister, Aileen Gregory; and brother, Scott Maple.
