Mr. J.E. "Jewel" Little, age 83 of Lovelady, passed away Sat. July 15, 2000 at his home in Lovelady. Mr. Little was born Sept. 19, 1917 in Lovelady, being reared in Lovelady and graduating from Weldon High School in 1936. He graduated with a B.S. degree in Agriculture from Sam Houston State University, teaching in the Magnolia Schools for five years and worked as the Assistant County Extension Agent of Harris County for four years.

Mr. Little was a charter member of the Pearland Rotary Club helping to organize the club serving as the first president and receiving the Paul Harris award in appreciation of significant assistance given for furtherance of better understanding relations of people of the world. He was also a member of the Tomball Masonic Lodge #1096 and a member of the Shriners for over 50 years. Mr. Little was also a member of the Houston Fat Stock Show and Rodeo from 1945 to 1976.

Mr. Little was a rancher and a member of the Lovelady First United Methodist Church. He was a kind, gentle man never meeting a stranger.

Survivors include wife of 59 years Florene Little of Lovelady; daughter Linda Sallee of Lovelady; granddaughters Alexis Sallee of San Antonio, Lauren Sallee of Huntsville; sister Edna Morgan of Houston; numerous nieces, nephews and other relatives.

Mr. Little was preceded on death by parents E.W. and Martha Little; brothers Bryant Little, Vince Little and Roy Little; sisters Ollie Little and Lottie Cook.

Funeral services for Mr. Little were held Tues. July 18 at 10:30 a.m. in the Lovelady First United Methodist Church with the Rev. Don Willis and the Rev. Doug Howell officiating. Interment followed in the Lovelady Antioch Cemetery.
