**CHARLES WAYNE
"CHUCK" LIVELY**

Mr. Charles Wayne "Chuck" Lively, age 67 of Arlington, passed away Sunday, July 18, 2004. Mr. Lively was born February 10, 1937 in Crockett to Jake and Eunice Lively and was a long time resident of Arlington and a native Texan. Mr. Lively was a retired Army Lieutenant Colonel, Executive Vice President of Trinity Improvement Association (TIA).

Mr. Lively was a member of the Corps of Cadets, graduating from Texas A&M University, Class of 1959 with a Bachelor of Science (Mathematics) degree at which time he was commissioned a Second Lieutenant. Mr. Lively later earned a Master's Degree from the University of Texas at El Paso. During his 27 years with the U.S. Army, he attended the Field Artillery Officer Basic and Advanced Course, Contracting Officer's School, and the U.S. Army Command and General Staff College.

Mr. Lively served two tours in Vietnam as Advisor to the Army of Vietnam with the U.S. Military Assistance Command, Operations Officer, 519th Military Intelligence Command, Southeast Asia, and Advisor, Vietnamese Forces, Pleiku,

Vietnam.

Mr. Lively was the Assistant Facility Engineer, Fort Bliss, Chief, Liaison Branch, U.S. Army Corps. of Engineers, Middle East, Riyadh, Saudi Arabia, and on returning to the United States, he was the Deputy District Engineer, U.S. Army Engineers, Fort Worth.

Mr. Lively was a decorated veteran having been awarded the Bronze Star with Oak Leaf Cluster, Meritorious Service Medal, Air Medal, Army Commendation Medal with Oak Leaf Cluster, and the Combat Infantryman Badge. Following retirement he served as the Vice President and General Manager of NAFA Enterprises, Riyadh, Saudi Arabia; and currently with the Trinity Improvement Association.

Survivors include his loving wife and best friend, Sharon E. Lively, of Arlington; brother and sister-in-law Captain Richard A. Eason (USN-Retired) and Billie B. Eason, of Orange Park, Fla.; and the light of his life, his nephew Jarrod A. Eason, of Orange Park, Fla.

Preceded in death by his mother and father Jake and Eunice Lively.

Graveside service for Mr. Charles Wayne "Chuck" Lively will be held Friday, July 23, at 10:00 a.m. in Dallas-Fort Worth National Cemetery, 2000 Mountain Creek Parkway, Dallas, TX.
