

CLYDE W. LOVELL

Mr. Clyde W. Lovell, age 85 of Crockett, passed away Thursday, December 26, 2002 in the East Texas Medical Center-Crcokett. Mr. Lovell was born August 18, 1917 in Weches and had lived all of his lifetime in Houston County.
