## Weches Rites For Former State Representative Lovell

Funeral services for Mr. Lacy Lovell of Weches were held Monday, August 7, at 5:00 p.m. in the Weches Baptist Church with Rev. Kenneth Mobley and Rev. Ottis Byers officiating. Interment followed in the Weches Cemetery.

Lacy Lovell was born September 10, 1932, in Weches and had been a resident of Houston County most of his lifetime. He passed away Saturday, August 5, 2000, at East Texas Medical Center in Crockett. Mr. Lovell saw military duty with the U. S. Air Force. He was a 32nd degree Mason belonging to the Augusta Masonic Lodge #93 and was a member of the Weches Baptist Church. He was an avid rancher.

From 1966 and 1972, Mr. Lovell served his home district as a representative in the Texas State Legislature. After his

service in the legislature, he was employed by the Texas Alcoholic Beverage Commission for 26 years.

Preceding him in death were his parent, Loyd and Gertie Lovell, and two uncles, Sherman Lovell and Elwin Lovell.
