JAMES ROBERT LOVER

Mr. James Robert "Jim" Lover, age 61 of Grapeland, passed away Monday, Dec. 6, 1999, at his residence. Mr. Lover was born May 11, 1938, in St. Paul Minnesota and had been a resident of Houston County since 1975.

He graduated from North Texas University and started his teaching career in 1961 with the Central Catholic High School in Taylor where he taught until 1965.
