## Lucille Ann Lucas

Graveside services for Mrs. Lucille Ann Lucas were held at 10:00 a.m. Friday, May 2, 2003 at the Augusta Cemetery. Arrangements were under the direction of Bailey & Foster, Grapeland. Honorary pallbearers selected were grandsons Chris Lucas, Scott Lucas, Jim Lucas and Blair Hartley. Evangelist Jamie Duplichan officiated.

Mrs. Lucas, age 92, died at her Grapeland home April 29 surrounded by loved ones. She was the widow of James Beeman Lucas, a Houstonian originally from Augusta, and the daughter of Ted and Ada Klaus of Austin.

Born in Kansas City, Missouri on April 8, 1911 Mrs. Lucas spent her childhood years in Taylor before moving to Austin, where she eventually met her future husband. After marrying, she devoted herself to her family, rearing three chil-

dren. Later, as an employee of the U.S. Social Security Administration, she retired after 31 years of service.

Especially delightful to her were children, cooking, homemaking, reading, and rose gardening. She revered the beauty of God's creation and demonstrated her trust in His sovereignty. Family and friends will remember her for her consistently joyful spirit, her radiant smile, her unfailing generosity and her unconditional love.
