Mr. Alfred Lee Massey, age 80 of Crockett, formerly of Houston, passed away Jan. 24 at the East Texas Medical Center Crockett. Mr. Massey was born Oct. 14, 1918, in Bremond Tx., to Jashua and Alice Massey. He was the next to the youngest of nine children.

Mr. Massey had been a resident of Crockett for the past three years, previously having resided in Houston most of his lifetime.

He was a veteran of World War II serving as a Sargeant in the United States Army, 26th Infantry Yankee Division.

Mr. Massey was awarded the Purple Heart for his service in the Battle of the Bulge. He was an insulator and a member of the International Local #22 Asbestos Workers Union in Houston.
