Mrs. Maude Edith Moore Mauk, age 90 of Grapeland, passed away Tuesday, March 4, 2008 at Houston County Nursing Home. Mrs. Mauk was born July 5, 1917 in the Liberty Hill Community to John Henry and Cora Young Moore. Mrs. Mauk attended schools in Liberty Hill, Glover, and Grapeland. Mrs. Mauk left home to work in Waco where she met her future husband, Roy N. Mauk of Oklahoma. They married in Austin in November of 1943 and began life of travel compliments of the U.S. Army.
