Charles Herbert McBryde

TRINITY – Services for Charles Herbert McBryde, 71, were held at 10 a.m. Monday, Aug. 7, 2006, in the Pine Ridge Baptist Church in Sour Lake with Clifton Rankin officiating.

Burial followed in the Pine Ridge Cemetery.

Mr. McBryde died Thursday, Aug. 3, in Trinity.

Born Dec. 15, 1934, in Durant, Miss., he served in the U.S. Army during the early 1950s and was stationed in Germany. He earned a degree in education from Southwest Texas University as well as a Bachelor of Science degree in business with a minor in government.

He continued his studies at Texas A&M University and after graduation, he taught school in Aransas Pass for one year, at Hardin Jefferson High School for 18 years and retired after 30 years while teaching in Jersey Village.

Mr. McBryde was a member of the Joe Werner Masonic Lodge No. 553 of Trinity.

He was preceded in death by his wife, Virginia; and his parents, Douglas and Eva Julia McBryde.
