James 'Jim' Doyle McCarty

TRINITY – Services for James "Jim" Doyle McCarty, 91, were held at 2 p.m. Monday, Dec. 17, 2007, in the Waller-Thornton Funeral Home with the Rev. Leroy Brown officiating.

Burial followed in Cedar Grove Cemetery in Trinity.

Mr. McCarty died Friday, Dec. 14, in Huntsville.
