TRINITY -- Graveside services for Eula Faye Smith McFarland, 70, of Trinity were held at 2 p.m. Saturday, Dec. 10, 2005, in Taylor Cemetery with Dr. Randy Lowe, pastor of the Trinity Calvary Baptist Church, officiating.

Mrs. McFarland died Dec. 1 in Houston as the result of injuries sustained in a traffic accident in Walker County.
