STAFFORD - Services for Robert A. Miller, 81, of Richmond were held at 10:30 a.m. Tuesday, April 17, 2007, at Earthman Southwest Chapel in Stafford with Deacon Don Ries officiating.

Burial followed at South Park Cemetery in Pearland.

Mr. Miller died Thursday, April 12.

Born July 12, 1925, in Abilene, he was the son of Robert A. Miller Sr. and Merle Miller. Mr. Miller was a former part-time resident of the Westwood Shores subdivision near Trinity.

He was a veteran of World War II, having served in the Pacific Theater in the U.S. Navy. He was vice president of Gordon Jewelers Corp., and retired after 29 years of service.

Mr. Miller served as a Dale Carnegie instructor, where he incorporated his skills as a public speaker. He was also a volunteer at M.D. Anderson Cancer Center.

Survivors include his wife of 62 years, Dorothy M. Miller; a son and his spouse, Michael and Shannon Miller; a daughter and her spouse, Janice and Roy Keith; his step-mother, Deb Miller; a sister-in-law, Patsy Reese; three grandchildren, Molly, Dyllan and Christian Miller; a niece, Jennifer Reese; and a number of friends.
