Instead of doing everything for him, she rented him a home of his own and taught him how to be independent, with a caregiver during the day but spending nights alone. He went shopping in his wheelchair, folded towels, put clothes in the washer and vacuumed while sitting in his wheelchair. Funeral services were held Tuesday, March 20, at Stine Kilburn Funeral Home in Lebanon, Ohio, with the Rev. Tom Chattin officiating. His body will be taken to Onalaska, where visitation will was held Saturday, March 24, at the Cochran Funeral Home Onalaska Chapel. A funeral service followed, with the Rev. Frank Hood officiating.
