## Loran Odell Wallace Myers

TRINITY - Services for Loran Odell Wallace Myers, 93, were held at 10 a.m. Wednesday, May 9, 2007, at the Trinity Pines Baptist Church with the Rev. Dennis Land and the Rev. Mark Gray officiating.

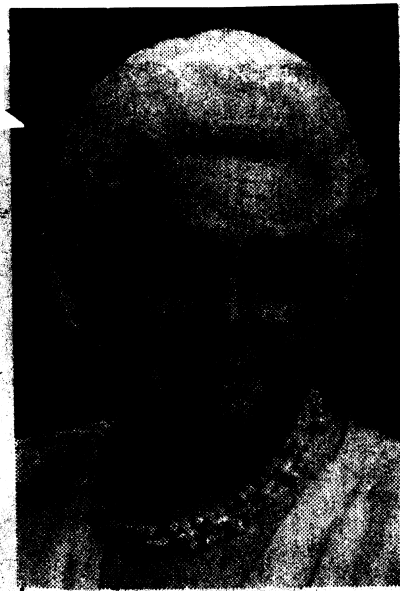
Mrs. Myers was a member of the First Assembly of God Church of Nacogdoches and was known as a strong Christian woman who never had a cross word about anyone or anything.
