Mr. Walter Naill, Jr., age 65 of Upland, California, passed away Thursday, June 28, 2007 near Tacoma, Washington. Mr. Naill was born April 21, 1942 in Houston, Texas and was a 1960 graduate of John F. Dulles High School.
