

## Jack Kirkland Nesbitt

TRINITY -- Services for Jack Kirkland Nesbitt, 70, of Huntsville were held at 11 a.m. Friday, Feb. 14, 2003, in the Trinity First United Methodist Church.

Burial followed in the Cedar Grove Cemetery in Trinity.

Mr. Nesbitt died in Huntsville on Tuesday, Feb. 11.

He was born Nov. 25, 1932,

Livingston and served in the U.S. Army during the Korean War. He earned a bachelor of arts degree in physical education with a minor in education from Sam Houston State University and served as a coach at Trinity High School from 1958 to 1960.

He continued his education at SHSU where earned a masters degree. He then worked at The American School Foundation in Monterey, Mexico before moving to Lockhart, Texas where he served as elementary and intermediate school principal.

Mr. Nesbitt also served a term as deputy superintendent for the Victoria Independent School District.

After retiring, he accepted a post with the Texas Department of Criminal Justice and served for six years as a medical trainer.

He was a member of the First United Methodist Church of Trinity and was preceded in death by a brother and two sisters.

Survivors include his wife of 45 years, Ann Nesbitt; a son, Kirkland Nesbitt; a daughter, Kathryn Beck; six grandchildren, Cole, Callie, Patricia, Sarah, Scott and Dallas; and numerous nephews, nieces and other relatives.
