TRINITY - Services for Patricia Newsom, 53, of Trinity were held at 3:30 p.m. Tuesday, Jan. 9, 2007, at Brooke Funeral Home Chapel in Huntsville with Pastor Mark Gray officiating.

Mrs. Newsom died Friday, Jan. 5.
