Mr. Jimmy R. Nix, age 65 of Crockett, went to be with the Lord Wednesday, Jan. 26, 2000. Mr. Nix was born Aug. 5, 1934, in Rising Star and had lived in Crockett since 1994, previously having lived in Galena Park.

Mr. Nix retired from the Galena Park Police Dept. after 25 years serving 17 years as Assistant Police Chief, retiring in 1994.
