

HUBERT ERLE NORTHCUTT

Mr. Hubert Erle Northcutt, age 79 passed away at his home in Rock Springs on Sunday, November 30, 2003. Mr. Northcutt was born September 23, 1924, in Graham, Oklahoma, son of Hubert and Ethel Northcutt. Mr. Northcutt served in the United States Navy during World War II. Mr. Northcutt had a long and versatile career in the oilfield from 1940 to 1986.
