Bruce Charles Oliver

TRINITY - Graveside services for Bruce Charles Oliver, 76, of Pasadena were held Monday, March 28, 2005, at the Glendale Cemetery with the Rev. Barbara Campbell officiating.

Mr. Oliver died Wednesday, March 23, in Pasadena.
