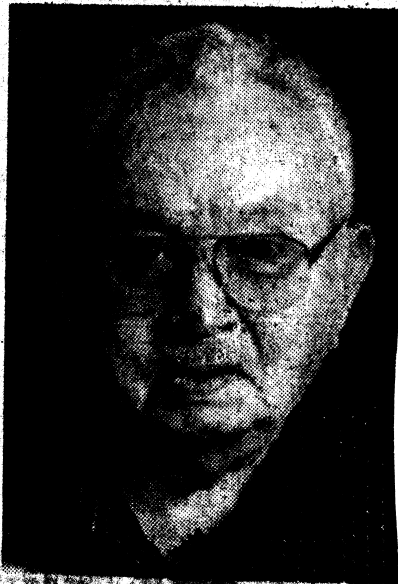
Burial followed in the Thornton Cemetery.
