Ernestine "Cotton" Price

TRINITY -- Graveside funeral services for Ernestine "Cotton" Price, 68, of Trinity were held at 2 p.m. Wednesday, Sept. 18, 2002, in the Codar Grove Cometery in Trinity with his nephew, Monty Price, officiating,

Mr. Price died Tuesday, Sept. 17, at his residence.

Born May 18, 1934, in Madison County, he was the son of Perry and Essie Hosier Price. He had resided in Trinity for 66 years, graduating from Trinity High School in 1951. Following his high school graduation, Mr. Price enlisted in the U.S. Air Force, returning to Trinity in 1956.
