Mr. Warren Pearson, age 79, of Crockett, succumbed after a lengthy battle with cancer Friday, February 15, 2002 in the Nacogdoches Memorial Hospital. Mr. Pearson was born February 9, 1923 in Vivian, L.A. and had been living in Crockett for the past 16 months, previously living in Texas City, and Shelby.
