Mr. Kyle Pendergraft, age 52 of Crockett, passed away Saturday, January 4, 2003 in the East Texas Medical Center-Crockett. Mr. Pendergraft was born July 10, 1950 in San Antonio and had been living in Crockett for the past 14 years. Mr. Pendergraft was a veteran of the U.S. Coast Guard having served during the Vietnam War and retired after serving over 20 years. Mr. Pendergraft had been working for the Crockett State School for the past 10 years and was a member of the All Saints Episcopal Church. Mr. Pendergraft retired a warrant officer after serving over 20 years in the U.S. Coast Guard. After retiring, Mr. Pendergraft worked for the Crockett State School (TYC) for nearly 10 years. Mr. Pendergraft then enrolled in college at Stephen F. Austin University and graduated May 2002 with a Bachelor of Business Administration, he minored in computer information systems. In September he went to work for the Information Technology Division of the Texas Department of Criminal Justice in Huntsville.
