TRINITY - Services for Marguerite Nobles Raley, 83, of Trinity were held at 10 a.m. Wednesday, April 18, 2007, at Dorcas Wills Memorial Baptist Church in Trinity with the Rev. Jason Burden and the Rev. Leroy Brown officiating.
