Mrs. Ethel Standley Ramsey, age 75 of Crockett, passed away Sunday, November 6, 2005 in the East Texas Medical Center-Crockett. Mrs. Ramsey was born June 28, 1930 in Port Arthur and had resided in Crockett since 1961. Mrs. Ramsey graduated from Warren High School in 1947 and attended East Texas Baptist College where she met her husband of 56 years, Reverend E.P. Ramsey, Jr. They married on August 22, 1949 in Hillister. Mrs. Ramsey was a faithful partner in Reverend Ramsey's ministry for over 50 years as they served together in seven churches including Mt. Zion Baptist-Lufkin in 1949, Fairplay Baptist-Beckville in 1951, First Baptist-Clayton in 1952, Reliance Baptist in 1954, First Baptist-Garrison in 1956, First Baptist-Kountze in 1959, and First Baptist-Crockett from February 14, 1961 to February 14, 1991. Mrs. Ramsey was active in the music ministry of all the churches where they served and particularly enjoyed being a part of the First Baptist Church in Crockett Choir. Additionally, she taught many Sunday School Classes including Mary Class at First Baptist Church-Crockett. Mrs. Ramsey was a consistent source of love and encouragement to her husband, children and grandchildren.
