James Garvin Reed

TRINITY - Services for James Garvin Reed, 82, of Trinity were held at 10 a.m. Thursday, Jan. 27, 2005, with the Rev. J. Lindsey Nimmons officiating.

Burial followed in Cedar Grove Cemetery in Trinity.

Mr. Reed died Sunday, Jan. 23, in Trinity.

He was born Jan. 28 1922, in Holly, the son of John Dennison Reed and Georgia Ola Morrow Reed. He served in the U.S. Navy during World War II.

A long-time resident of Trinity, he was employed by Texas Long Leaf Lumber Co., Millwhite in Riverside, produce manger for Brookshire Brothers grocery, maintenance at Sam Houston College and for a short time with the Texas Department of Criminal Justice.

He was preceded in death by his daughter, Mary Jane London in 2002.

Survivors include his wife, Delora Barnett Reed; two sons and their spouses, James Garvin and Sharon Reed Jr. of Gilbert and Billy Ray and Inetha Reed of Longview; and three grandsons, James Reed, Matt London and Rodney London.
