Clarence 'Tiny' Reeves Jr.

TRINITY – A memorial service for Clarence "Tiny" Reeves Jr., 79, were held at 11 a.m. Saturday, Feb. 23, 2008, at Faith Baptist Church of Riverside with the Rev. Humphrey officiating.

Mr. Reeves died Thursday, Feb. 14, in Conroe.

He was born Dec. 6, 1928, in Fort Scott, Kansas, son of Clarence Burt and Gladys Melton Reeves Sr. He served in the U.S. Navy for three years in San Francisco, Calif., during peacetime.

Mr. Reeves resided on the Pacific Coast for most of his life and was employed as an electrician. He served as the supervisor over the electrical engineering when a number of government dams were being built in California.
