TRINITY – Services for Billy J. Reynolds, 61, of Trinity were held at 2 p.m. Tuesday, May 10, 2005, in the Waller-Thornton Funeral Home Chapel in Trinity.

Burial followed in the Chalk Cemetery.

Mr. Reynolds died Friday, May 6, at his residence.

Born Aug. 16, 1943, in Houston, he was the son of Syble Brewton and Joseph H. Reynolds. A graduate of Pasadena High School, he served in the U.S. Navy aboard the U.S.S. Intrepid during the Cuban Missile Crisis of 1962.

Mr. Reynolds was in the burglar alarm business in Houston for many years and was preceded in death by his father; brother, Jackie; and sister, Connie.
