### George Lertin Sarver, Sr.

Funeral services for George Lertin Sarver were held on Monday, September 22, 2003 at 1:00 p.m. at the Callaway-Allee Funeral Home with Rev. E. P. Ramsey (family friend and retired pastor) and Rev.
