Alfred Henry Shipes

TRINITY - A memorial service for Alfred Henry Shipes, 55, of Trinity will be held at 1 p.m. Saturday, Sept. 3, 2005, at the Lake Livingston Lutheran Church of Onalaska with Pastor Sharon Kapsch officiating. Mr. Shipes died at his residence

on Wednesday, Aug. 24.

Born Oct. 5, 1949, in St. Francisville, La., he was the son of John Henry and Mary Evelyn Shipes. He was an electrical designer for the Mustang Engineering Co., and served in the U.S. Coast Guard from 1969 to 1974.
