## Herman Elmer Snowden

TRINITY -- Services for Herman Elmer Snowden, 79, were held at 11 a.m. Wednesday, April 28, 2004, in the Glendale Baptist Church near Trinity with the Rev. Bobbie Bailey and the Rev. Jon Valenta officiating.

Burial followed in Glendale Cemetery.

Mr. Snowden died Monday, April 26, in Huntsville with his family at his side.
