Funeral services were held Tuesday, June 12, 2007 for Brittney Lyn Sonnier, 20, at Hillier Funeral Home in Bryan. Interment followed in College Station City Cemetery. She was born on December 1, 1986 in Houston, the daughter of David and Brenda McRae Sonnier. She died on June 7, 2007.
