## **Mack McCoy Standley**

CONROE - Memorial services for Mack McCoy Standley, 78, of Oak Ridge North in Montgomery County were held at 11 a.m. Tuesday, Dec. 28, 2004, at Crossroads Baptist Church in The Woodlands.

Burial took place at 2 p.m. on Monday, Dec. 27, in the Bennett Cemetery in Trinity County.

Mr. Standley died Saturday, Dec. 25, following a short illness.

He was born Nov. 11, 1926, in the Helmick community of Trinity County, the son of Lee and Narcissus Standley. He had been a resident of Oak Ridge North for the past 26 years.
