## Nathan Eugene Standley

TRINITY - Trinity attorney Nathan Eugene "Gene" Standley, 49, died Monday, Sept. 26, 2005, at Trinity Memorial Hospital.

No funeral services are planned at Mr. Standley's request. His family said he would prefer to be remembered with a party full of music and laughter.

Mr. Standley served in the U.S. Air Force in the 1970s and completed his undergraduate degree at Sam Houston State University, graduating in 1997. He graduated from the Thurgood Marshall School of Law and has been practicing law in Trinity since 2001.

Mr. Standley was an attorney in Trinity since 2001.

He was also known in the Trinity, Onalaska and Shepherd area as a musician and worked as a journalist for a number of years, serving as the editor of the *Shepherd Citizen* for several years while attending SHSU.

Mr. Standley was fondly known by his nieces and nephews as "Uncle Dammit."

He was preceded in death by his parents, Eloise and Jerry Standley of Shepherd.

Survivors include his spouse, Judy Ann Smith of Trinity; two brothers, Gerald E. Standley II and Jonathan S. Standley; a sister, Kim D. Standley Georgiou; and six nieces and nephews, Starr Standley Gallagher, Celeste Standley, Laura Georgiou, Sean Georgiou, Michael Georgiou and Patrick E. Georgiou.
